SECTION 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That Sections 142-155, inclusive, of Article 7 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland (1930 Edition), be and they are hereby repealed.

SEC. 2. And be it further enacted, That this Act shall take effect June 1, 1941.

## CHAPTER 63.

## (Senate Bill 120)

AN ACT to repeal and re-enact, with amendments, Section 2 of Article 7 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland (1930 Edition), title "Carroll County," sub-title "Almshouse," authorizing the appointed agent or agents of the County Commissioners to make sales and purchases for the County Almshouse of Carroll County.

SECTION 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That Secton 2 of Article 7 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland (1930 Edition), title "Carroll County", sub-title "Almshouse", be and it is hereby repealed and re-enacted, with amendments, to read as follows:

- 2. They shall visit the almshouse at least once in every three months, either personally or by a committee of their number, to examine into the condition and affairs of the institution; shall levy upon the assessable property of the county for any actual or expected deficiency of means for its support, and they shall themselves, or by their appointed agent or agents, make all sales and purchases that may be necessary or proper in conducting the affairs of the farm and almshouse, and do all other acts and things necessary for the proper management of the same.
- SEC. 2. And be it further enacted, That this Act shall take effect June 1, 1941.
