

any person or persons contemplating matrimony, or for the purpose of soliciting to bring, take or direct said person or persons contemplating matrimony to another person or persons for the performance of said ceremony of matrimony. Any person or persons violating the provisions of this sub-title shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction thereof shall be fined not less than \$10.00 nor more than \$50.00 for each offense, or not more than sixty (60) days in jail, or both.

SEC. 2. *And be it further enacted*, That this Act shall take effect June 1, 1943.

CHAPTER 841.

(Senate Bill 452)

AN ACT to add a new section to Article 18 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland (1930 Edition), title "Queen Anne's County," sub-title "County Commissioners," to be under sub-heading "Printing and Advertising," said new section to be known as Section 192A and to follow immediately after Section 192 of said Article, relating to the publication of all laws, advertisements, notices or other printing required by the County Commissioners, Supervisors of Elections or other officials of Queen Anne's County, and repealing all laws inconsistent therewith.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That a new section be and it is hereby added to Article 18 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland (1930 Edition), title "Queen Anne's County," sub-title "County Commissioners," to be under sub-heading "Printing and Advertising," said new section to be known as Section 192A, to follow immediately after Section 192 of said Article, and to read as follows:

192-A. As to all legal notices, advertising or publication in newspapers published in Queen Anne's County by the County Commissioners, Supervisors of Elections or any other official of Queen Anne's County, whether required by Public General or Public Local Laws, it shall be sufficient to publish the same in one newspaper published in said County, anything in any Public General or Public Local Law
