Whereas, the provisions of these sections have apparently been superseded by the provisions of Article 52 of the State Code relating to Justices of the Peace and particularly by the Act creating the Trial Magistrates system; therefore

SECTION 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That Sections 256-276 of Article 18 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland (1930 Edition), title "Queen Anne's County," sub-title "Justices of the Peace and Constables," be and they are hereby repealed.

SEC. 2. And be it further enacted, That this Act shall take effect June 1, 1943.

## CHAPTER 853.

## (Senate Bill 469)

AN ACT to repeal Sections 418-422 of Article 18 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland (1930 Edition), title "Queen Anne's County," sub-title "Weights and Measures," said Sections relating to the keeper of weights and measures in Queen Anne's County.

Whereas, these Sections are no longer applicable; therefore

SECTION 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That Sections 418-422 of Article 18 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland (1930 Edition), title "Queen Anne's County," sub-title "Weights and Measures," be and they are hereby repealed.

SEC. 2. And be it further enacted, That this Act shall take effect June 1, 1943.
