

he shall see that the ordinances of the town are faithfully executed and shall report to the council at its first meeting each year the condition of municipal affairs; he shall have the power of vetoing any ordinances, as hereinafter provided in Section 335. From and after the General Election on the Fourth Tuesday in March, 1945, he shall receive an annual salary of Three Thousand Six Hundred (\$3,600.00) Dollars, provided that the duly qualified Mayor serving until said election in 1945, shall receive, in addition to his present salary the sum of \$100.00 per month as an expense account, and no other fee or compensation whatsoever.

SEC. 2. *And be it further enacted*, That this Act shall take effect June 1, 1943.

CHAPTER 861.

(Senate Bill 475)

AN ACT to authorize the State Roads Commission to name a certain road in the Tenth Election District of Worcester County the Sinepuxent Road, and relating to the taking over and maintaining of said road by the said Commission; and to repeal Chapter 819 of the Acts of 1941.

CHAPTER 862.

(Senate Bill 476)

AN ACT to repeal Sections 423-424, inclusive, of Article 6 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland (1930 Edition), title "Caroline County", sub-title "Officers' Fees", said sections relating to the manner of keeping accounts for officers' fees.

Whereas, the provisions of these sections are no longer necessary or applicable; therefore

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That Sections 423-424, inclusive, of Article 6
