CHAPTER 863.

(Senate Bill 477)

AN ACT to repeal Sections 349-364, inclusive, of Article 6 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland (1930 Edition), title "Caroline County", sub-title "Justices of the Peace and Constables", said sections relating to Justices of the Peace and Constables for the several Election Districts in Caroline County.

Whereas, the state law relating to Justices of the Peace and Constables, and particularly the Trial Magistrates' System, have superseded the provisions of these sections; therefore

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That Sections 349-364, inclusive, of Article 6 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland (1930 Edition), title "Caroline County", sub-title "Justices of the Peace and Constables", be and they are hereby repealed.

SEC. 2. *And be it further enacted*, That this Act shall take effect June 1, 1943.
