SEC. 4. And be it further enacted, That this Act is hereby declared to be an emergency law and necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health and safety, and having been passed upon a yea and nay vote, supported by three-fifths of all the members elected to each of the two Houses of the General Assembly, the same shall take effect from the date of its passage.

## CHAPTER 865.

## (Senate Bill 480)

AN ACT to repeal Section 560 of Article 6 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland (1930 Edition), title "Caroline County", sub-title "State's Attorney", said section relating to the fees to be collected by the Sheriff for the State's Attorney.

Whereas, the State's Attorney for Caroline County is now paid a salary, thereby making this section unnecessary; therefore

SECTION 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That Section 560 of Article 6 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland (1930 Edition), title "Caroline County", sub-title "State's Attorney", be and it is hereby repealed.

SEC. 2. And be it further enacted, That this Act shall take effect June 1, 1943.

## CHAPTER 866.

## (Senate Bill 481)

AN ACT to repeal and re-enact with amendments Sections 60 and 61 of Article 2B of the Annotated Code of Maryland, 1939 Edition), title "Alcoholic Beverages", sub-title "Boards of License Commissioners", for the purpose of providing the annual salary of the members of the Board of License Commissioners for Baltimore City and the
