WHEREAS, The general election laws have superseded the provisions of this section; therefore

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That Section 143 of Article 5 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland (1930 Edition), title “Calvert County”, sub-title “Elections”, be and it is hereby repealed.

SEC. 2. *And be it further enacted,* That this Act shall take effect June 1, 1943.

CHAPTER 898.

(Senate Bill 532)

AN ACT to repeal Sections 300 and 301 of Article 5 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland (1930 Edition), title “Calvert County”, sub-title “Swine in Lower Marlborough”, making it unlawful to permit swine to go at large in Lower Marlborough.

WHEREAS, The provisions of these sections are no longer necessary; therefore

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That Sections 300 and 301 of Article 5 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland (1930 Edition), title “Calvert County”, sub-title “Swine in Lower Marlborough”, be and they are hereby repealed.

SEC. 2. *And be it further enacted,* That this Act shall take effect June 1, 1943.
