

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That Sections 213 and 214 of Article 9 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland (1930 Edition), title "Charles County", sub-title "Officers' Fees", be and they are hereby repealed.

SEC. 2. *And be it further enacted,* That this Act shall take effect June 1, 1943.

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CHAPTER 905.

(Senate Bill 539)

AN ACT to repeal Sections 152-161, inclusive, of Article 9 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland (1930 Edition), title "Charles County", sub-title "Justices of the Peace and Constables", said sections relating to the Justices of the Peace and Constables for the several Election Districts and to the jurisdiction of said Justices.

*Whereas,* the general laws of the State relating to Justices of the Peace, and particularly to Trial Magistrates, have superseded the provisions of these sections; therefore

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That Sections 152-161, inclusive, of Article 9 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland (1930 Edition), title "Charles County", sub-title "Justices of the Peace and Constables", be and they are hereby repealed.

SEC. 2. *And be it further enacted,* That this Act shall take effect June 1, 1943.

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CHAPTER 906.

(Senate Bill 540)

AN ACT to repeal Section 212 of Article 9 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland (1930 Edition), title "Charles County", sub-title "Notices—Legal", said section relating to certain notices to be given in the newspapers by executors, trustees, etc.
