

with the provisions of this Act be and they are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistencies.

SEC. 4. *And be it further enacted*, That if any section, sub-section or provision of this Act is held invalid for any reason, such invalidity shall not in any way affect any other section, sub-section or provision of this Act, and the remainder of this Act shall continue in full force and effect as if such invalid section, sub-section or provision had not been included.

SEC. 5. *And be it further enacted*, That this Act shall take effect June 1, 1943.

CHAPTER 970.

(House Bill 335)

AN ACT to repeal and re-enact, with amendments, Sub-section (3) of Section 80 of Article 101 of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1939 Edition), title "Workmen's Compensation", sub-title "Miscellaneous", as said sub-section was amended by Chapter 627 of the Acts of 1941, exempting certain employers of cutters of pulp wood from the provisions of the Workmen's Compensation Laws.

CHAPTER 971.

(House Bill 340)

AN ACT to amend Article 17, of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland (1930 Edition), title "Prince George's County", sub-title "Riverdale", by adding thereto new sections to be known as Sections 865A, 865B, 865C, 865D, 865E, 865F, 865G, 865H and 865-I to extend the limits of the Mayor and Common Council of Riverdale, a municipal corporation, by including therein a part of Prince George's County contiguous thereto.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That new sections be and are hereby added to Article 17, of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland (1930 Edition),
