Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That Section 475 of Article 17 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland (1930 Edition), title "Prince George's County", sub-title "Hyattsville", be, and the same is hereby repealed and re-enacted, with amendments, to read as follows:
- 475. The citizens of the town of Hyattsville, in Prince George's County, are hereby created a body corporate by the name of "The Mayor and City Council of Hyattsville", with all the powers and privileges of a body politic, corporate, and by said corporate name may have perpetual succession, sue and be sued, plead and be impleaded, in any Court of law or equity; may have and use a common seal, may purchase and hold real, personal and mixed property, and sell and dispose of the same for the benefit of the town.
- Sec. 2. And be it further enacted, That this Act shall take effect June 1, 1943.
