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CHAPTER 254.

(Senate Bill 116)

AN ACT to repeal Sections 59 and 60 of Article 7 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland (1930 Edition), title "Carroll County", sub-title "Foxes".

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That Sections 59 and 60 of Article 7 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland (1930 Edition), title "Carroll County", sub-title "Foxes", be and they are hereby repealed.

SEC. 2. *And be it further enacted*, That this Act shall take effect June 1, 1943.

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CHAPTER 255.

(Senate Bill 198)

AN ACT to repeal Sections 856 to 859, inclusive, of Article 4 of the Public Local Laws and Baltimore City Charter (1938 Edition), title "Baltimore City," sub-title "Notaries Public," said Sections relating to the appointment of Notaries Public in Baltimore City.

*Whereas*, Article 68 of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1939 Edition) provides generally for the appointment of Notaries Public throughout the State, thereby making the local law unnecessary; therefore

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That Sections 856 to 859, inclusive, of Article 4
