CHAPTER 385.

(Senate Bill 342)

AN ACT to repeal Sections 513-520 of Article 12 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland (1930 Edition), title "Garrett County", sub-title "Trespass".

*Whereas*, the general laws relating to trespass seem to make the provisions of these sections unnecessary; therefore

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That Sections 513-520 of Article 12 of the Code of Public Local Laws (1930 Edition), title "Garrett County", sub-title "Trespass", be and they are hereby repealed.

SEC. 2. *And be it further enacted*, That this Act shall take effect June 1, 1943.

CHAPTER 386.

(Senate Bill 343)

AN ACT to repeal Sections 506 and 507 of Article 12 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland (1930 Edition), title "Garrett County", sub-title "Sunday Observance", said sections relating to hunting and fishing in Garrett County on Sunday.
