said sections relating to the impounding of cattle, horses, etc.

Whereas, the provisions of these sections are no longer necessary or applicable; therefore

SECTION 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That Sections 171-173, inclusive, of Article 1 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland (1930 Edition), title "Allegany County", sub-title "Fences", be and they are hereby repealed.

SEC. 2. And be it further enacted, That this Act shall take effect June 1, 1943.

(Senate Bill 375)
