

*Whereas*, the present State law as to tramps and vagabonds applies to Frederick County; therefore

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That Section 758 of Article 11 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland (1930 Edition), title "Frederick County," sub-title "Tramps," be and it is hereby repealed.

SEC. 2. *And be it further enacted*, That this Act shall take effect June 1, 1943.

#### CHAPTER 93.

(Senate Bill 158)

AN ACT to repeal Sections 632-633 of Article 11 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland (1930 Edition), title "Frederick County," sub-title "Navigation," said Sections relating to the removal of old fish dams and obstructions in the Monocacy River.

*Whereas*, the provisions of these Sections are no longer applicable; therefore

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That Sections 632-633 of Article 11 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland (1930 Edition), title "Frederick County," sub-title "Navigation," be and they are hereby repealed.

SEC. 2. *And be it further enacted*, That this Act shall take effect June 1, 1943.
