

184. The County Commissioners for Queen Anne's County shall meet as often as they may deem necessary; provided, that they shall hold not less than one meeting in each week, and each of said County Commissioners shall receive as compensation for his services a sum not exceeding five hundred dollars per year. In addition, each Commissioner shall receive not exceeding three hundred dollars (\$300.00) each year for traveling and other expenses in the performance of his duties.

SEC. 2. *And be it further enacted*, That this Act shall take effect June 1, 1943.

CHAPTER 700.

(House Bill 312)

AN ACT to add two new sections to Article 3 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland (1930 Edition), title "Baltimore County", said new sections to be under a new sub-title "Public Works", said new sections to be known respectively as 544A and 544B, and to follow immediately after Section 544 of said Article, the same providing for a Department of Public Works of Baltimore County, and authorizing and empowering the County Commissioners of Baltimore County to appoint and pay the salary and expenses of a Chief Engineer of Baltimore County and such personnel as may be necessary for the operation and maintenance of the office of the Department of Public Works; to provide for the rights, duties and powers of the Chief Engineer of Baltimore County.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That two new sections be added to Article 3 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland (1930 Edition), title "Baltimore County", said new sections to be under a new sub-title "Public Works", said new sections to be known respectively as 544A and 544B and to follow immediately after Section 544 of said Article, and to read as follows:

PUBLIC WORKS

544A. There shall be a Department of Public Works of Baltimore County, the head of which department shall be the Chief Engineer of Baltimore County. The County Commissioners of Baltimore County are authorized and empowered
