

may be adopted in the manner directed for proposing the same and shall name the date when it is to become effective. It shall be a misdemeanor to violate such regulation, or any part thereof, and any person convicted of such violation shall be fined not less than Ten Dollars (\$10.00) nor more than Fifty Dollars (\$50.00) and may be sentenced to thirty (30) days in jail, either, or both, in the discretion of the Court or Justice of the Peace before whom said person shall be tried. A copy of any regulation adopted by the Commission shall be mailed to the Clerk of the Circuit Court who shall make a record thereof and cause the same to be posted in front of the Court House of the County.

#### DEPUTIES

6. The Game Warden shall have the power to appoint deputy game wardens to assist him in more efficiently enforcing the game and inland fish laws of this State, he may issue a commission signed by him to such persons as he may designate to act as Deputy Game Wardens to enforce said laws, who shall be known as "non-salaried deputy game wardens." Such persons may be appointed for the whole State or such county or counties, city or cities, as the Game Warden may designate. Such deputy game wardens shall not receive a salary from the State, county or counties, or cities, but shall be paid such compensation out of the State Game Protection Fund as the Game Warden may determine.

The Game Warden is authorized, with the consent of the Commission, to appoint salaried deputy game wardens who shall be known as District Deputy Game Wardens, Regional Deputy Game Wardens (said Regional Wardens shall supervise the District Deputy Game Wardens in their respective regions), and Wildlife Technicians, Biologists, or Scientists, each of these appointees to be paid such compensation as the Commission and Game Warden may determine and allowed necessary traveling expenses and other expenses incurred by him in the discharge of his official duties subject to such regulations and limitations as the Game Warden may from time to time see fit to establish, and all appointments shall be made under the Merit System in accordance with Article 64A of the Code.

All Deputy Game Wardens shall perform such duties as the Game Warden may designate, including the guarding of streams and waters of the State against pollution.

7. The Game Warden shall issue to each person so appointed as Deputy Game Warden a commission and badge stating "Non-salaried Deputy Game Warden" or "Salaried
