Which was read the first time and referred to the Committee on Judiciary.

House Bill No. 3—By Mr. Buffington:

A Bill entitled "An Act to add a new section to Article 33 of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1947 Supplement), title 'Elections', said new section to be known as Section 51A, to follow immediately after Section 51 of said Article, and to be under the sub-title 'Nominations and Primaries', changing the day for the primary elections to be held by the political parties during the month of September, 1950."

Which was read the first time and referred to the Committee on Elections.

House Bill No. 4—By Mr. Buffington:

A Bill entitled "An Act to add a new section to Article 33 of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1947 Supplement), title 'Elections', said new section to be known as Section 25B, to follow immediately after Section 25A, as Section 25A was enacted by Chapter 749 of the Acts of 1949 and to be under the sub-title 'Registration', providing for an additional day for a supplemental registration of voters in each precinct in the City of Baltimore in the year 1950 on a day to be fixed by the Governor."
