

## CHAPTER 62

(Senate Bill 160)

AN ACT to repeal and re-enact, with amendments, Sub-sections (b) (2), (b) (4) and (b) (5) of Section 287 of Article 93 of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1947 Supplement), as amended by Chapter 690 of the Acts of 1949, title "Testamentary Law", sub-title "Register of Wills", increasing the salaries of the Registers of Wills of Somerset and Wicomico Counties.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That Sub-sections (b) (2), (b) (4) and (b) (5) of Section 287 of Article 93 of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1947 Supplement), as amended by Chapter 690 of the Acts of 1949, title "Testamentary Law", sub-title "Register of Wills", be and they are hereby repealed and re-enacted, with amendments, to read as follows:

(2) The Registers of Wills for Caroline, Charles, **[Wicomico,]** Worcester, *and* St. Mary's **[and Somerset]** Counties shall each be entitled to receive the annual salary of \$3,000.

(4) The Register of Wills of Dorchester, Harford, Kent, Queen Anne's, Cecil, *Somerset* and Talbot Counties shall each be entitled to receive the annual salary of \$3,600.

(5) The Register of Wills of Anne Arundel, Howard, **[and]** Prince George's, *and Wicomico* Counties shall each be entitled to receive the annual salary of \$4,000.

SEC. 2. *And be it further enacted,* That this Act shall take effect June 1, 1950.
