20. TO THE BEQUEST OF \$150.00 TO THE TRUSTEES OF MANRESA-ON-SEVERN, INC., CONTAINED IN THE LAST WILL AND TESTAMENT OF HARRY S. SHERWOOD, LATE OF BALTIMORE COUNTY, DECEASED, OF RECORD IN THE OFFICE OF THE REGISTER OF WILLS FOR BALTIMORE COUNTY, IN WILLS LIBER J. P. C., NO. 42, FOLIO 529.

21. (A) ACQUISITION BY THE FIRST UNITED EVANGELICAL CHURCH FROM HARRY T. BARK AND WIFE OF THE PROPERTY AT 804 S. ROSE STREET, BALTIMORE, MARYLAND, RECORDED IN BALTIMORE CITY LIBER M. L. P. NO. 7694 FOLIO 109 OF FEBRUARY 4, 1949.

(B) LEASE FROM THE FIRST UNITED EVANGELICAL CHURCH TO HARRY T. BARK AND WIFE ON THE SAME PROPERTY RECORDED IN LIBER M. L. P. NO. 7694 FOLIO 112 OF FEBRUARY 4, 1949.
