

SEC. 7. *And be it further enacted*, That this Act is hereby declared to be an Act dealing with an acute emergency and to be legislation in the general public welfare.

SEC. 8. *And be it further enacted*, That this Act shall take effect June 1, 1950.

SEC. 7. *And be it further enacted*, THAT THIS ACT IS HEREBY DECLARED TO BE AN ACUTE EMERGENCY AND NECESSARY FOR THE IMMEDIATE PRESERVATION OF THE PUBLIC HEALTH AND SAFETY AND HAVING BEEN PASSED BY A YEA AND NAY VOTE, SUPPORTED BY THREE-FIFTHS OF ALL THE MEMBERS ELECTED TO EACH OF THE TWO HOUSES OF THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY, THE SAME SHALL TAKE EFFECT FROM THE DATE OF ITS PASSAGE.

CHAPTER 106

(House Bill 171)

AN ACT to add a new section to the Code of Anne Arundel County (1947 Edition), being Article 2 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland, said new section to be known as Section 274A, to follow immediately after Section 274 of said Code and to be under the new sub-title "Districts", describing the metes and bounds of the eight districts of Anne Arundel County.

WHEREAS, the metes and bounds of the eight Districts of Anne Arundel County have never been described, thereby leaving the precise boundaries of these Districts uncertain; and

WHEREAS, this uncertainty causes confusion in the application of the continuous assessment laws since there are no established boundaries which assessors can follow in the assessment of property; and

WHEREAS, the lack of any definite specifications as to boundaries of the several Districts also causes practical dif-
