Boone, II., Secretary of State of the State of Maryland, pursuant to the direction contained in Section 203 of Article 33 of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1947 edition) do hereby certify, That at an election held in the Town of District Heights, Prince George's County, Maryland, on May 2, 1949, an Act known as Chapter 25 of the Session of the General Assembly of 1949, was submitted to the voters of the Town of District Heights, for their adoption or rejection under the provisions thereof, said Act being:
