CHAPTER 62.

AN ACT to refund to the Society of the Redemp-
torists, certain sums of money for State taxes
erroneously paid by them. Passed Feb.
23, 1860.

WHEREAS, The Redemptorists were incorporated a
Society for religious, literary and charitable pur-
poses by an act of the General Assembly of Mary-
land, passed December session; eighteen hundred
and forty-one, chapter twenty-six; *And whereas*,
the said Society in ignorance of their rights, paid
taxes upon their property in Anne Arundel county,
where they now reside to the amount of fifty-three
dollars and ninety-one cents, which property be-
longing to an incorporated literary and charitable
institution was exempted from taxation under the
act of eighteen hundred and forty-one, chapter
twenty-three; therefore, Preamble.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly
of Maryland*, That the Treasurer be and he is
hereby required to pay upon the warrant of the
Comptroller, to the order of Michael Müller, Su-
perior of the House of Redemptorists or to the
order of his successor, the sum of fifty-three dol-
lars and ninety-one cents, for State taxes erroneously
paid by said Redemptorists to the State. Money re-
funded.

SEC. 2. *Be it enacted*, That this act shall take
effect from its passage. In force.
