SEC. 2. And be it enacted, That this act shall take In force. effect from the date of its passage.

CHAPTER 65.

An ACT, to incorporate the Lloyd's Landing Passed Feb Wharf Company, at Lloyd's Landing, in Talbot 24, 1860. county.

Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly Incorporated. of Maryland, That James Bartlett, Jr., E. L. F. Hardcastle and Gibson W. Wright, and their associates, successors and assigns, be and they are hereby created a corporation and body politic, by the name of the Lloyd's Landing Wharf Company, and by that name may have succession and shall be able and capable in law to sue and be sued, plead and be impleaded, answer and be answered unto, in any court of law or equity in this State, and to make and use a common seal, to ordain and establish such by-laws and regulations as shall be necessary and convenient for conducting the affairs of said corporation.

- SEC. 2. And be it enacted, That the capital stock Capital stock of said company shall not exceed the sum of five thousand dollars, nor less than the sum of five hundred dollars to be divided into shares of twenty dollars each.
- SEC. 3. And be it enacted, That for the manage-president and ment of the affairs of said company the stockhold-directors. ers shall elect a President and not over five Directors to manage the affairs for one year, or until their successors shall be elected, a majority of whom shall form a quorum or board for the transaction of business.
- SEC. 4. And be it enacted, That the company shall have full power and authority to levy, charge and collect, from all vessels of every description whatsoever, using said wharf, the same reasonable tolls or wharfage that may now be sanctioned by

Wharfage.
