SEC. 2. *And be it enacted*, That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage. In force.

CHAPTER 65.

An ACT, to incorporate the Lloyd's Landing Wharf Company, at Lloyd's Landing, in Talbot county. Passed Feb 24, 1860.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That James Bartlett, Jr., E. L. F. Hardcastle and Gibson W. Wright, and their associates, successors and assigns, be and they are hereby created a corporation and body politic, by the name of the Lloyd's Landing Wharf Company, and by that name may have succession and shall be able and capable in law to sue and be sued, plead and be impleaded, answer and be answered unto, in any court of law or equity in this State, and to make and use a common seal, to ordain and establish such by-laws and regulations as shall be necessary and convenient for conducting the affairs of said corporation. Incorporated.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted*, That the capital stock of said company shall not exceed the sum of five thousand dollars, nor less than the sum of five hundred dollars to be divided into shares of twenty dollars each. Capital stock.

SEC. 3. *And be it enacted*, That for the management of the affairs of said company the stockholders shall elect a President and not over five Directors to manage the affairs for one year, or until their successors shall be elected, a majority of whom shall form a quorum or board for the transaction of business. President and directors.

SEC. 4. *And be it enacted*, That the company shall have full power and authority to levy, charge and collect, from all vessels of every description whatsoever, using said wharf, the same reasonable tolls or wharfage that may now be sanctioned by Wharfage.
