CHAPTER 76.

AN ACT to amend the two hundred and third section of twenty-first article of the Code of Public Local Laws relating to the number of justices of the peace for District Number Five, in Washington county.

21st article.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That section two hundred and three of article the twenty-first of the Code of Public Local Laws be and the same is hereby repealed, and the following enacted as a substitute therefor:

There shall be the following number of justices of the peace and constables for Washington county, to wit: For election district number one, two justices of the peace and two constables; for election district number two, three justices of the peace and three constables; for election district number three, four justices of the peace and four constables; for election district number four, two justices of the peace and two constables; for election district number five, three justices of the peace and two constables, one of which said justices of the peace shall be appointed by the Governor as soon as practicable after the passage of this act; who shall hold his office until the next general election for the House of Delegates, when he or some other person shall, as now required by law, be elected by the people of said district, and one of the three said justices of the peace shall always be taken from the town of Hancock; for election district number six, two justices of the peace and two constables; for election district number seven, two justices of the peace and two constables; for election district number eight, two justices of the peace and two constables; for election district number nine, two justices of the peace and two constables; for election district number ten, two justices of the peace and two constables; for election district number eleven, two justices of the peace and two constables; for election district number twelve, two justices of the peace and two constables; for election district number thirteen, two justices of the peace and two constables.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted,* That this act shall take effect from and after its passage.
