CHAPTER 100.

AN ACT to amend the eighty-second Section of Article two of the Code of Public Local Laws, relating to the salary of the Clerk to the County Commissioners for Anne Arundel county. Passed Feb. 28, 1860.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That the eighty-second section of article two of the Code of Public Local Laws, relating to the salary of the clerk to the county commissioners for Anne Arundel county be and the same is hereby repealed, and the following enacted as a substitute therefor: The clerk to the county commissioners for Anne Arundel county shall receive such salary as the said commissioners may determine.
