SEC. 8. *And be it enacted*, That nothing herein contained shall be construed as to authorize this corporation to issue any device, token, note, certificate, or other evidence of debt, to be used as a currency. CHAP. 145.
Construction.

SEC. 9. *And be it enacted*, That the right is hereby expressly reserved to the General Assembly of Maryland, at its pleasure, to alter and amend or repeal this act of incorporation. Reservation.

CHAPTER 145.

AN ACT to authorize and empower William Briscoe, James C. Milburn, Henry Jones, J. L. Briscoe and Uriah Tippett, and their successors, to receive by conveyance a tract of land to be used for a parsonage, and to hold the same in trust for the Methodist Episcopal Church of St. Mary's county. Passed Feb.
24, 1860.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That William Briscoe, James C. Milburn, Henry Jones, J. L. Briscoe and Uriah Tippett, of St. Mary's county, be and they are hereby authorised and empowered to purchase and hold to them and their successors in office a tract of land lying in said county, from George P. Leach and Joseph B. Davis, containing thirty-six acres of land, more or less, and to appropriate and hold the same as a parsonage for the use of the Methodist Episcopal church of Saint Mary's county. SEC. 2. *And be it enacted*, That this act shall take effect from the day of its passage. In force.
