## CHAPTER 157.

Passed March AN ACT entitled, an act to amend the one hun-2, 1860. dred and sixty-eighth and one hundred and sixtyninth sections of article sixteen of the Code of Public Local Laws relating the compensation of the sheriff of Prince George's county.

Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly Repealed. of Maryland, That the one hundred and sixtyeighth and one hundred and sixty-ninth sections of article sixteen of the Code of Public Local Laws relating to the sheriff, be and the same are hereby repealed, and the following enacted as a substitute therefore:

Sec. 2. The sheriff of said county shall be allowed Compensation fifty cents a day for keeking and supporting each person committed to the jail of said county, for breach of the peace or any criminal offence, to be levied and paid by the county commissioners.

> Sec. 3. He shall be entitled to receive fifty cents a day for keeping and supporting each runaway slave committed to said jail, to be paid by the owner thereof.

> Sec. 4. He shall be entitled to receive two dollars a day for attendance upon the Orphans' court of said county, to be levied and paid by the county commissioners.

Sec. 5. And be it enacted, That this act shall In force. take effect from the date of its passage.
