CHAPTER 158.

CHAP. 159.

AN ACT to provide for making indices to the Land and other Records in the Clerk's office for Charles county, and directing the county commissioners to levy by a tax, a sufficient sum to pay for the same. Passed March 2, 1860.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That the clerk of the Circuit court for Charles county, be and he is hereby authorised to prepare or have prepared a correct and faithful index for each and every land record and all other records in his office which are not already provided with indices. Authorised to prepare index.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted,* That the county commissioners be and they are hereby authorised to levy at their next levy laying term on the assessable property of the said county, a sum sufficient to pay for the execution of the same. Compensation

SEC. 3. *And be it enacted,* That this act shall take effect its passage. In force.

CHAPTER 159.

AN ACT further carrying out the provisions of the nineteenth section of article four of the Constitution, by adding new sections to the seventy-fourth article of the Code of Public General Laws, by authorizing the removal of causes from the several courts of Baltimore city. Passed March 2, 1860.

*Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That the following sections be added to the seventy-fourth article of the Code of Public General Laws: Sections added.

SECTION 1. That in all suits or actions at law, issues from the Orphans' court or other court sitting in equity, in petitions for freedom, and in all presentments or indictments now pending, or which Cases in the courts removable.
