therefor: The commissioners of primary schools Chap. 175. may appoint a clerk, who shall receive such compensation for his services as the said commissioners of primary schools may determine, to be levied on the assessable property of the county by the county commissioners of said county.

SEC. 2. And be it enacted, That this act shall In force. take effect from the date of its passage.

CHAPTER 173.

AN ACT to authorise the vestry of Prince George's Passed March parish, in Montgomery county, to hold a lot of land, not exceeding fifteen acres, for a parsonage and burying ground.

Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the vestry of Prince George's parish, in Montgomery county, be and they are hereby authorised to take, have, and hold, in perpetual succession, a lot or parcel of land, lying and being in said county, not exceeding in the whole "fifteen acres" of land, to be used, improved and enjoyed only for said purposes.

SEC. 2. And be it enacted, That this act shall take In force. effect from the date of its passage.
