CHAPTER 181.

AN ACT to compensate J. M. Hauck, sheriff of Passed March  
Washington county, for services rendered and 8, 1860.  
expenses incurred by him, by authority of the  
Governor.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly* Authorised  
*of Maryland*, That the treasurer, on the warrant to pay.  
of the Comptroller, be, and he is hereby directed,  
to pay J. M. Hauck, sheriff of Washington county,  
the sum of seven hundred and seventy-five dollars,  
for services rendered and expenses incurred by him,  
under authority from the Governor of Maryland,  
during the John Brown riad.

Sec. 2. *And be it enacted*, That this act shall In force.

CHAPTER 182.

AN ACT to amend the seventh section of article Passed March  
thirty-three of the Code of Public General Laws, 3, 1860.  
relating to the Indigent Blind, and to make ad-  
ditional provision for their instruction.

WHEREAS, it was enacted by the General Assem- Preamble.  
bly of Maryland, by law passed at the January  
session, eighteen hundred and fifty-four, chapter  
two hundred and twenty-four; that the sum an-
