SEC. 3. If any of the commissioners herein shall die, resign or refuse to act or remove from Worcester county, the remaining commissioners shall appoint a commissioner in his place, so as to keep up the number herein appointed. **Vacancies—how filled.**

SEC. 4. *And be it enacted,* That this act shall take effect from the day of its passage. **In force.**

CHAPTER 197.

AN ACT entitled, An act to compensate John Cullen for services rendered and losses incurred in the discharge of his duties as an officer of the State. **Passed March 2, 1860.**

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That the Treasurer, on the warrant of the Comptroller, be, and he is hereby, directed to pay to John Cullen the sum of nine hundred and sixty-eight dollars and forty-four cents, in full for services rendered the State and losses incurred by him in the discharge of his duty as an officer of the State. **Authorised to pay.**

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted,* That this act shall take effect from its passage. **In force.**

CHAPTER 198.

AN ACT to amend the one hundred and forty-sixth section of the sixteenth article of the Code of Public Local Laws of Prince George's county, relating to the school fund of said county. **Passed March 2, 1860.**

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That the one hundred and forty-sixth **Repealed.**
