## CHAPTER 197.

- AN ACT entitled, An act to compensate John Cul- Passed March len for services rendered and losses incurred in <sup>2, 1860</sup>. the discharge of his duties as an officer of the State.
- SECTION 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly Authorised of Maryland, That the Treasurer, on the warrant to pay. of the Comptroller, be, and he is hereby, directed to pay to John Cullen the sum of nine hundred and sixty-eight dollars and forty-four cents, in full for services rendered the State and losses incurred by him in the discharge of his duty as an officer of the State.
- SEC. 2. And be it enacted, That, this act shall In force; take effect from its passage.

## CHAPTER 198.

AN ACT to amend the one hundred and forty-sixth Passed March section of the sixteenth article of the Code of Public Local Laws of Prince George's county, relating to the school fund of said county.

Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the one hundred and forty-sixth
