CHAPTER 201.

AN ACT to allow William Thompson, of C., late collector of taxes in the first election district of Montgomery county, further time to complete his collections. Passed Feb. 29, 1860.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That from and after the passage of this act, William Thompson, of C., late collector of the first election district of Montgomery county, be and he is hereby authorised and empowered, to collect until the first day of January, eighteen hundred and sixty-one, all sums and balances due him, as collector of said first election district in said county, in the same manner which the said William Thompson, of C. could or might have done within the time now limited by law. Authorised to complete collections.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted*, That it shall be the duty of the said William Thompson, of C., before he proceeds to execute the property of any person or persons for taxes in virtue of this act, to deliver to such person or persons, charged with the same, at least thirty days previous to the laying of such execution, a fair account in writing of the taxes demanded of him, her or them, and an affidavit there-to annexed, that he hath not directly or indirectly received any part thereof, or any thing in security or satisfaction for the same, (more than the credits given, if any,) to the best of his knowledge.
