CHAP. 208.

CHAPTER 207.

Passed March 6, 1860. AN ACT to refund to Henry T. Scott, administrator of William Scott, late collector of State and county taxes for Prince George's county, certain moneys over paid by said administrator into the Treasury of Maryland.

Authorised to pay. SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That the Treasurer, upon the warrant of the Comptroller, is hereby authorized and required to pay to Henry T. Scott, administrator of William Scott, late collector of State and county taxes for Prince George's county, the sum of eighty-four dollars and fifty-seven cents, with interest on the same from the first day of January, eighteen hundred and fifty-one, over paid by said Henry T. Scott into the treasury.

In force SEC. 2. *Be it enacted,* That this act shall take effect from and after the date of its passage.

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CHAPTER 208.

Passed March 2, 1860. AN ACT appropriating a sum of money to pay Alexander B. Hagner, attorney for Tucker, Tongue and O'Hara, Nicholas H. Green, clerk of the Circuit Court for Anne Arundel county, Levin Woolford, clerk of the Circuit Court for Somerset county, J. S. Inloes, John Clark, and Whitney and Cushing for services rendered and articles furnished the State.

Authorised to pay. SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That the Treasurer, upon the warrant of the Comptroller, is hereby authorized and directed to pay to Alexander B. Hagner, attorney for Tucker, Tongue and O'Hara, ninety-four dollars and thirty-eight cents, costs due by the State in the case of the State vs. Tucker, Tongue and O'Hara, to Nicholas H. Green, clerk of the Circuit
