SEC. 2. *And be it enacted*, That the number of directors of the Manchester Savings' Institution be increased to nine, to be chosen at the next annual election for directors, in the manner provided by the original act incorporating said institution; *Provided*, that at each annual election of directors two of the preceding board of directors authorized by this act shall be ineligible for re-election for the next ensuing year.

## CHAPTER 222.

AN ACT for the benefit of Madison Gassaway, one of the legal representatives of Henry Gassaway, late of Anne Arundel county, deceased.

Passed March  
6, 1860.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That the Treasurer, upon the warrant of the Comptroller, is hereby directed to pay to Madison Gassaway, one of the legal representatives of Lavinia Gassaway, the widow of Henry Gassaway, late lieutenant in the war of the Revolution, the sum of two hundred and fifty dollars, and which said sum of money shall be in full of all claim said Madison Gassaway, as legal representative may possess, for bounty land and rations, and money expended by his father, the late Henry Gassaway, and the pension due his mother, the late Lavinia Gassaway.
