SEC. 3. *And be it enacted*, That this act of incorporation shall take effect from the date of its passage, and that the Legislature reserves to itself the right to alter and amend the said act of incorporation at pleasure.

CHAPTER 225.

AN ACT entitled, an act to provide for disposing of the State's Tobacco Warehouses, and for the building of a new Tobacco Warehouse or Warehouses on deep water.

Passed March 6, 1860.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That Richard H. Miles, John D. Bowling and William Thompson, of R., be and they are hereby appointed commissioners to dispose of the property known as the State Tobacco Warehouses in the city of Baltimore, or of so much thereof as may be necessary for the purposes of this act, and to erect a new Warehouse or Warehouses in their stead as hereinafter provided.

Commissioners to dispose of warehouses

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted*, That before the said commissioners shall proceed to act, they shall take and subscribe before the clerk of the Superior court for Baltimore city an oath or affirmation that they will faithfully discharge their duties as commissioners under this act, and shall also severally enter into bonds in the penalty of fifty thousand dollars each, conditioned for the faithful discharge of their duties under this act, which bonds shall be approved by the Governor or Comptroller of the State, and be lodged for record in the office of the clerk of the Superior court for the city of Baltimore, and a copy thereof under the seal of the
