CHAPTER 230.

AN ACT to authorize Juliana Hall, of Harford **Passed March**  
county, to convey two lots of ground to St. John's **7, 1860.**  
Church, in Havre-de-Grace.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly* **Authorised**  
*of Maryland*, That Juliana Hall, of Harford coun- **to convey.**  
ty, be, and she is hereby, authorized to convey to  
the vestry of St. John's Church, in Havre-de-Grace,  
Harford county, two lots of ground in the town of  
Havre-de-Grace, Harford county, and the said ves-  
try is hereby authorized to hold the property thus  
conveyed, or sell or convey the same for the use of  
said church.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted*, That this act shall **In force.**  
take effect from the day of its passage.
