CHAPTER 244.

Passed March 9, 1860. AN ACT to pay John T. Wright a sum of money for services rendered as assistant doorkeeper to the Senate.

Authorised to pay. SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That the Treasurer of the State be and he is hereby authorised and directed to pay John T. Wright, upon the warrant of the Comptroller of the State, the sum of two hundred dollars, for services rendered as assistant doorkeeper to the Senate, since the adjournment of the last General Assembly of Maryland, under order by the Senate, at January session, eighteen hundred and fifty-eight, as per Senate Journal, page six hundred and eight.

In force. SEC. 2. *And be it enacted,* That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage.
