Certificate to The said judges shall lodge with the clerk of the be lodged Circuit court for the county, or the clerk of the with clerk of Superior court of Baltimore city, within five days court. or sooner if practicable, from their meeting as aforesaid, the books of the polls of all the districts in the county, or precincts in the city of Baltimore, together with a certificate of all the votes given in the said districts or precincts.

The following shall be a substitute for the forty-49th section ninth section of said article:

Warrants for all special elections, shall be issued Warrants. to the sheriff of the county or city where the election is to be held, who shall appoint a day for the holding of the same, and shall give at least ten days notice thereof, exclusive of the day of publication and day of election, by advertisement set up at the most public places within each district of the county, and by advertisement in two newspapers of general circulation in such county; in the city of Baltimore, three weeks previous, notice shall be given in the manner herein prescribed of all special elections, whether for federal, State or municipal officers.

The following shall be a substitute for the fiftieth 50th section. section of said article:

The sheriff shall also serve a copy of the said Notice to be served. warrant together with a notice of the day appointed for holding said election on each of the judges in each district or precinct, at least three days before the day appointed for holding the election, under the penalty of ten dollars for each neglect.

That the following be a substitute for the fifty-51st section. first section of said article:

Such election shall be held within fifteen days of Election to be held. after the warrant shall be received by the sheriff, except in the city of Baltimore, where twenty-five
