CHAP. 263. sections of said act, anything in the said ^{act to the} contrary notwithstanding, and that said ^{Queen-} Anne's County Railroad Company may be fully incorporated according to the provisions of said act.

CHAPTER 262.

Passed March 9, 1860. AN ACT to change the name of Shalmanezer Newman to Sidney Charles Newman.

Name changed. SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That the name of Shalmanezer Newman be and the same is hereby changed to Sidney Charles Newman.

In force. SEC. 2. *Be it enacted,* That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage.

CHAPTER 263.

Passed March 10, 1860. AN ACT to allow Robert Pippin, late collector of State and county taxes for Caroline county, further time so complete his collections, and to give him full authority to do so.

Authorised to complete collections SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That Robert Pippin, late collector of the State and county taxes for Caroline county, be and he is hereby authorised and empowered for twelve months from the passage of this act to complete his collections as collector of State and county taxes, with the same and as full authority to compel and force payment of the taxes due him as collector as aforesaid, as he had when he was first appointed and qualified as collector as aforesaid; *Provided,* that nothing herein contained shall be construed to extend the time of payment over any
