AN ACT to change the name of Anna Elizabeth Passed March Blowmerour to Anna Elizabeth Durnbaugh.

5, 1860.

SECTION 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly Name of Maryland, That the name of Anna Elizabeth Blowmerour, of Washington county, be and the same is hereby changed to Anna Elizabeth Durnbaugh, and that by the said last name she may take, hold, sell and dispose of real, or personal, or mixed property, may sue and be sued and do all other lawful acts whatsoever.
