Richardson, Joseph Richardson, Wm. McClelland, Nicholas Hiss, George Earle and Frances Green, and the said sale has been finally ratified and confirmed by the said Circuit court for Cecil county, in chancery, but doubts are entertained, whether the purchasers under said decree could lawfully exercise the rights and franchises heretofore conferred upon, and exercised by said company; and whereas, it is important for the interests of many citizens of Cecil county, especially of those living along, and near to said road, that the said road should be kept in good condition and repair, which can only be done by conferring ample powers and authority upon the purchasers aforesaid to exercise the said rights and franchises to their full extent; Therefore,
