CHAPTER 298.

AN ACT entitled, An act to incorporate a company Passed March to construct a turnpike road from Hagerstown to Cearfoss' cross-roads, in Washington county.

Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly Incorporated. of Maryland, That Daniel Cearfoss, Henry Zeller, Dr. A. B. Scott, F. T. Zeigler, Samuel Zeller, John Horst, Daniel Rife, Peter Negly, Benjamin Eshelman, Joseph P. Mong and all other persons who may have, or shall hereafter subscribe to the stock of said company, be and they are hereby incorporated a body politic for making a turnpike road, to commence at some point within the corporate limits of the town of Hagerstown and extending to Cearfoss' c oss-roads.

SEC. 2. And be it enacted, That the capital stock Capital stock: of said company shall not exceed fifteen thousand dollars, to be divided into shares of twenty-five dollars each, and as soon as the sum of five thousand dollars shall have been subscribed, a majority of president and the subscribers shall give two week's notice in one managers. or more newspapers published in Hagerstown of the time and place designated by them for the shareholders to meet for the purpose of organizing said corporation, who shall then and there choose by a plurality of votes, and by ballot, a president and five managers, any three of whom shall form a quorum, and in the same manner to elect a treasurer, and such other officers as they shall deem necessary for conducting the affairs of said company until the first Saturday of November thereafter, and until a new election shall be held, which said election shall take place annually, on the first Saturday of November, and the said president and managers shall make such rules, regulations and
