CHAPTER 316.

CHAP. 317.

AN ACT authorising the State Librarian to furnish the clerk of the Circuit court of Worcester county, with certain acts of Assembly, and Alexander's Chancery Practice. Passed March 3, 1860.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That the State Librarian be authorised and requested to furnish the clerk of the Circuit Court of Worcester county, with copies of the acts of Assembly, passed at December session, eighteen hundred and forty-three and eighteen hundred and forty-three, also one copy of Alexander's Chancery Practice; *Provided,* the same can be spared from the Library. Authorised to furnish copies

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted,* That this act shall take effect from the time of its passage. In force.

CHAPTER 317.

A SUPPLEMENT to the act entitled, an act to incorporate the Franklin Savings Bank of Frederick. Passed March 8, 1860.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That the Franklin Savings Bank of Frederick, shall be and is hereby authorised to issue promissory notes in sums of not less than five dollars, which notes shall be signed by the president and secretary and made payable to order; *Provided,* that the amount of notes issued, shall not exceed double the amount of stocks to be estimated at their market value for which certificates be held by said bank of the State of Maryland, the State of Virginia, State of Missouri or other State and the city of Baltimore, which stocks shall constitute a fund for the redemption of the issues of said bank, and shall be pledged to redeem the same; *and provided,* that no note or notes shall be issued until said bank shall be in possession of certificates of said stock to the amount of notes in cir- Authorised to issue promissory notes.
