AN ACT to appropriate a sum of money for the re-  
demption and repayment of unused stamps and  
to authorise the Comptroller to redeem the same. Passed March  
9, 1860.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That the sum of five thousand dollars, Appropriation.  
or so much thereof as may be found necessary, be and the same is hereby appropriated for the repayment of all monies which have been paid into the treasury under the act of March tenth, eighteen hundred and forty-five, entitled, an act imposing duties on promissory notes, bills of exchange, specialties and other instruments of writing, to aid in paying the debts of the State, for stamped paper or papers, which shall appear from evidence, satisfactory to the Comptroller, not to have been used within the meaning and intent of said act.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted,* That the treasurer shall redeem all paper or papers issued under said act, which shall be presented to him for redemption prior to the thirtieth day of September, eighteen hundred and sixty-one, properly certified by the Comptroller; *Provided,* he does not exceed the amount appropriated for that purpose in section first of this act. Redemption of papers.

SEC. 3. *And be it enacted,* That this act shall take effect from the day of its passage. In force.

CHAPTER 321.

AN ACT to amend the two hundred and fifty-  
fifth and two hundred and seventy-fifth sections  
of article twenty-one of the Code of Public Local  
Laws, so far as the same relates to public schools  
in Washington county. Passed March  
10, 1860.
