And be it enacted, That the following section Additional authorising free negroes to renounce their freedom section. shall be added to said article, and is hereby declared to be a part thereof:

SEC. 2. Any free negro above the age of eigh- Free negroes teen years, may go before the Circuit court for the renounce county in which such free negro has resided for their freedom. three years, next preceding such application or before the Superior court of Baltimore city, if such negro has resided in said city, and after a full examination in open court by said court, so as to ascertain whether force, fraud, imposition or undue persuasion has been used to induce such application, and upon being perfectly satisfied by such examination, and by any other evidence, which the said court may think it proper to inquire, that such application has not been induced by force, fraud, imposition or undue persuasion, the said court may permit such negro to select a master or mistress and become a slave for life to such master or mistress, and shall cause such order to be recorded in perpetual proof of the fact; if such negro shall be a female, her children if any under five years of age, shall be included in such order and become slaves, and those above five shall be bound out.

## CHAPTER 323.

AN ACT to incorporate a company to build a Passed March Turnpike Road from the Georgetown Turnpike 9, 1860. to the public road leading from Adamstown to Greenfield Mills.

SECTION 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly Incorporated. of Maryland, That a company be incorporated to make a turnpike road from the Georgetown turnpike to the public road leading from Adamstown
