to issue any note, token, scrip, certificate or other Chap. 324. evidence of debt to be used as currency.

SEC. 21. And be it enacted, That this act of in-Reservation. corporation, shall continue in force for thirty years, and that the General Assembly hereby reserves the right to alter, amend or repeal this act at pleasure, and that it shall take effect after the passage In force. thereof.

CHAPTER 324.

AN ACT to incorporate the Farmers' and Mechan-Passed March ics' Marine Railway Company of Sharptown, Somerset county.

Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly Incorporated. of Maryland, That John J. Burgess, John Cooper, Richard P. Darby, Jonathan W. Benson, Isaac J. W. Adams, Major A. Robinson, Thomas A. Marrill, Arthur McCleary and Elijah Robinson, of Somerset county, Maryland, and their associates. successors and assigns, be and they are hereby incorporated and made a body politic and corporate by the name of the Farmers' and Mechanics' Marine Railway Company, and by that name have perpetual succession and a common seal, with power to acquire, hold and sell and transfer estate, real, personal and mixed, to sue and be sued, and to exercise and enjoy all the rights, powers and privileges, usually enjoyed by bodies politic and corporate, and also the power to make and establish rules, by-laws and regulations for their own government, the same not being repugnant to any law of this State or of the United States.

- SEC. 2. And be it enacted, That the objects of Objects of corporation. said corporation shall be building, repairing and cleaning vessels and the doing and performing of such other acts, as are usually and ordinarily done by Marine Railway Companies.
- SEC. 3. And be it enacted, That the capital stock Capital stock. of said corporation shall consist of not less than fifteen hundred nor more than three thousand dol-
