CHAPTER 331.

AN ACT appropriating a sum of money for the **Passed March**  
payment of the claims of S. S. Dawson, Charles **10, 1860.**

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly* **Appropriation.**  
*of Maryland,* That the sum of two hundred and  
fifty-six dollars and eighty-three cents is hereby ap-  
propriated for the payment of the claim of S. S.  
Dawson for excess of license erroneously paid into  
the treasury; for the payment of Charles H. Mann,  
for excess of license erroneously paid into the trea-  
sury; for the payment of the president of the Balti-  
more and Susquehanna Steam company for the  
amount of judgment against the State for costs in  
the suit of the State of Maryland versus the Balti-  
more and Susquehanna Steam company; for the  
payment of Montgomery Johns, executor of John  
Johns, for amount of collateral inheritance tax on  
negro Ben, set free by John Johns; for the pay-  
ment of Reuben Summers, for costs paid in the  
cases of the State vs. Anna Maria Forest and  
others; for the payment of John G. Hanshaw, for  
enveloping, directing and mailing the Code of Local  
and Public Laws to the clerks of the several coun-  
ties of this State, per order of the House of Dele-  
gates.
