SEC. 13. And be it enacted, That said company No banking shall not exercise any banking powers, or issue any privileges. paper to be used as currency.

SEC. 14. And be it enacted, That this act shall Inforce take effect from the date of its passage, and the State of Maryland shall have and hereby reserves to itself the power at any time hereafter to repeal Reservation or alter this charter.

CHAPTER 354.

AN ACT to refund to Mrs. Mary Tabler, certain Passed March moneys erroneously paid.

6, 1860.

Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the Comptroller of the Treasury, to pay be and he is hereby directed to issue his warrant to the Treasurer, for the payment of the sum of twenty-two dollars and sixty-five cents, erroneously paid by her to the collector of State taxes, in the second election district of Montgomery county, and by him paid into the Treasury, and the Treasurer be and he is hereby directed to pay the same.
